

LEGAL AID IN DISTRICT 10 HELPED

STABILIZING A FAMILY AFTER A NATURAL DISASTER



Lara, a single mother with young children, survived the Memorial Day weekend tornadoes, but the storms severely damaged the roof of her rental home. Lara notified her landlord, and the landlord installed a tarp and some plywood.

Because the tarp was secured poorly, water and rodents began coming into Lara's home, but her landlord was unresponsive. Lara and her children were scared of the rodents and had gotten sick from the moisture in the house, so they turned to legal aid for help. Legal aid contacted Lara's landlord and requested immediate action to repair the roof. Within three days of the call, the landlord sent a contractor to repair the roof and ceiling. Lara and her children are now safe and happy in their home, and the tornadoes are a story of the past.
