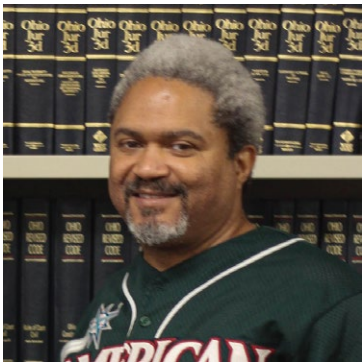


# LEGAL AID IN OHIO HELPED

Sanford Tubbs, an Army veteran, joined the military right after high school graduation so that he could provide for his infant daughter. During his military service, Sanford experienced a traumatic incident and later he struggled with civilian life.

After a number of years of trying to manage on his own, Sanford reached out to legal aid for help.

Legal aid helped Sanford establish that he suffers from post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and access the disability benefits he earned through his service to the country. Sanford is now financially secure, receiving ongoing treatment for his PTSD, and enjoying time with his daughter and grandchildren.
