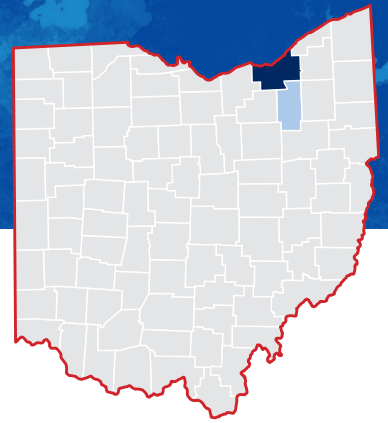

HELPING A MOTHER ESCAPE HER ABUSIVE HUSBAND



Monica Miller,* a mother of two, suffered sustained and ongoing abuse by her husband. After he put her in the hospital during a violent outburst, Ms. Miller decided to divorce her husband. Her situation was especially dire because she had just lost her waitressing job due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Worried about her safety and financial stability, Ms. Miller contacted legal aid for help.

Legal aid represented Ms. Miller during the divorce hearing. Thanks to legal aid, Ms. Miller's divorce was finalized, and she received both child and spousal support. Ms. Miller is now back to work at her old job, and she and her children are moving forward with their lives.
