Saving a Senior Veteran From Eviction

Peter Sutton,* an elderly Navy veteran, contracted COVID-19 and became quite ill. Because of his illness, Mr. Sutton experienced financial hardship and fell behind on his rent. When Mr. Sutton's landlord filed an eviction against him, Mr. Sutton planned to handle it himself, but was too sick to attend court on the day of his hearing. Fearing he could lose his home, Mr. Sutton contacted legal aid for help.

Legal aid worked to obtain rental assistance for Mr. Sutton. Thanks to Ohio's rental assistance program, Mr. Sutton was brought current on his rent. As a result, legal aid had the eviction dismissed, and Mr. Sutton remains stably housed while he continues to recover from COVID.
