Protecting a Mother From Abuse

Rosemary Jennings,* a mother of young children, worked diligently to provide for her family. Ms. Jennings' domestic partner kept threatening and harassing Ms. Jennings both at home and while she was at work. Desperate to break free from her abusive partner, Ms. Jennings contacted legal aid.

Legal aid helped Ms. Jennings obtain a Civil Protection Order (CPO) that prohibits her abusive partner from being in their home or contacting her at work. Legal aid also provided Ms. Jennings with additional safety planning and information on available domestic violence resources. Ms. Jennings is now free from her partner's abuse and can start a new life with her children in safety.
