Helping a Domestic Violence Survivor Gain Safety and Rebuild

Once a domestic violence survivor successfully escapes her abuser, she should be able to live in peace, safety, and security. Alina Tanner* courageously found the strength to leave her abusive boyfriend and father of her child. Her boyfriend, however, relentlessly continued to stalk and threaten her. Determined to protect herself and her child, Ms. Tanner turned to legal aid for help.

Legal aid secured a civil protection order for Ms. Tanner, protecting her from her boyfriend's harassment, so that she can focus on healing as she works to rebuild a life of safety and security for her family.
